



## CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR NEW PUPPY!



The Doctors and Staff at Flying Cloud Animal Hospital have prepared the following checklist to help keep track of your puppy's health requirements for the first few months. Please bring this list along when you bring your puppy in for visits.

### 8 Weeks Old

- 1<sup>st</sup> Canine Distemper vaccination – series of 3 boosters  
(Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus & Coronavirus)
- Fecal Examination (Intestinal parasite screening- about 1tsp of fresh sample is needed)
- Begin once-monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative

### 12 Weeks Old

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Canine Distemper booster
- 1<sup>st</sup> Bordetella vaccination- Intranasal (“Kennel Cough” vaccine)
- 1<sup>st</sup> Lyme Disease vaccination (Optional vaccine, discuss with your veterinarian)
- Fecal Examination (If not already completed)
- Monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative

### 16 Weeks Old

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Canine Distemper booster
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bordetella booster- SQ
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Lyme Disease booster
- Initial Rabies vaccination
- Fecal Examination (If not already completed)
- Monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative

### 5 – 6 Months Old

- 4DX Heartworm/Tick Disease Panel (Simple blood-test for heartworm & 3 common tick-borne diseases)
- Pre-Surgical bloodwork (Discuss options with your veterinarian or veterinary technician)
- Monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative

\*Spay or neuter can be done at this age

### 1 Year from last set of vaccines

- Canine Distemper vaccine
- Bordetella vaccine
- Rabies vaccine
- Lyme Disease vaccine
- Fecal Examination
- 4DX Heartworm/Tick Disease Panel
- Continue monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative
